There were lots of classes going on from Thursday through Sunday. Here's photos from my Fancy Filigree and Cholla carving classes.










You can use ordinary cake hand soap or <u>Murphy's oil soap</u> to recondition paintbrushes that have dried paint in the bristles. *Don't bend the bristles until after they have softened, as they could break.
